Abstract Submission Guidelines

Deadline to Submit Abstract – 15.11.2017

Step-by-step guide for developing and submitting an Abstract

Step 1: Choose a topic from the list below:

- Case study by State Generating and Transmission Companies indicating technological challenges being faced by them on account of large scale power generation from renewable sources.
- Multifarious applications of Energy Storage – Grid Stabilization, Solar vehicles, etc.
- Dynamic Modeling of Variable Renewable Generation for Grid Integration Studies
- Long term battery energy storage solutions
- Application and Technology of thermal storage
- Chemical energy storage solutions
- Pumped Hydro storage technology and its application
- Regulatory & Financing issues associated with Energy

Step 2: Topic Presentation Guidelines

- Estimated presentation length; 15-20 minutes, excluding time for Q&A
- Submission of the manuscript to conference organizer is required in advance to enable its publication in seminar literature.

Step 3: Develop a well written, concise synopsis of your proposed presentation topic that addresses all key points of issue/project/technology, not to exceed 2000 characters.

Step 4: Mail submission Abstracts must be submitted at v.anand@steag.in. Also furnish the following details:

- Speaker's and Co-author's name
- Title/Designation
- Company name
- E-mail Id
- Phone Number
- Biography (not to exceed 1500 characters) with photograph

Once the abstract has been submitted, an email acknowledgement will be sent.

Please note: By submitting an abstract you are indicating your availability and willingness to develop, attend and present your paper at International Seminar on "Energy Storage Options for Renewable Energy Integration" at India Habitat Centre on 29th January 2018, if selected, and comply with all deadlines.
